Stewards of Children, a child sexual abuse prevention workshop will be offered by several facilitators in Aiken: Gayle Lofgren, Child Advocacy Center of Aiken County, Cheryl Lapaquette of Aiken County Schools, Peggy Ford of Children’s Place and Susan Meehan of Aiken Youth Empowerment.

The Stewards of Children training is targeted towards helping adults learn how to better understand and prevent child sexual abuse. The training was created by “Darkness to Light,” an organization in Charleston, SC. The format for the training is video, workbook and discussion based.
